

Volunteer Opportunities

Recreation Assistants – Volunteers support clients living at Golden West Centennial Lodge and Adult Day Program clients in a wide variety of activities ranging from sensory stimulation and cognitive activities to one on one support on community outings, physical activities and many other recreation and leisure opportunities.

Gift Shop Attendant – Volunteers run the gift shop located on the main floor at Golden West Centennial Lodge. Volunteers serve customers, price items, stock shelves and handle cash transactions.

Chapel Assistants – Volunteers support residents living at Golden West Centennial Lodge to attend church services in the lodge throughout the week. Volunteers assist throughout the service as needed by the Spiritual Care Coordinator.

Friendly Visitors – Volunteers spend time visiting with residents at GWCL in a casual setting (reading, walks, playing games, etc.).

Gardening – Volunteers assist the maintenance and recreation staff with planting, weeding and general maintenance of the Golden West Centennial Lodge grounds.

Individually Tailored Opportunities to Volunteer – Tailored volunteer opportunities can often be arranged to match interests, skill development needs and availability during the day, the evening or on the weekend.
